



# Waste Disposal & Recycling Disposition



ORI Environmental profiles and handles a wide variety of non-hazardous and hazardous waste streams. Our goal is to find the most economic and environmentally friendly disposal method for our customers. For convenience and peace of mind, listed below are types of waste and recyclable products we handle and the disposal methods available.

## Common Sense Solutions for your environmental needs

- **USED MOTOR OIL**- Used motor oil is collected and tested, manifested and recycled as burner fuel (burning for energy) at our facility in Oklahoma City for industrial clients in accordance with (IAW) local, state, and federal regulations.
- **140 FLASH SOLVENT**- As part of our solvent recycling program, ORIE recycles non-chlorinated, high flash parts washer solvent, sludge and residue through fuel blending.
- **USED OIL FILTERS**- Used oil filters are containerized and brought back to our Oklahoma City facility for processing. Used oil filters are crushed into bricks for used oil recovery and metal recycling. The filter bricks are sent in bulk to scrap metal recyclers.
- **USED ANTIFREEZE**- Used antifreeze collected is brought back to our Oklahoma City facility and shipped in bulk to authorized recycling facilities IAW local, state, and federal regulations.
- **INDUSTRIAL WASTE WATER**- Waste water and sludge is collected in bulk and brought back to our Oklahoma City facility for processing. All waste water and sludge is profiled and manifested IAW with local, state, and federal regulations. Waste water is discharged at our facility IAW Oklahoma City regulations and sludge is disposed of at a permitted landfill.
- **NON-HAZARDOUS WASTE**- Non-hazardous waste is profiled, containerized, and transported for disposal to a permitted landfill or a "waste to energy" facility IAW local, state, and federal regulations.
- **HAZARDOUS WASTE**- Hazardous waste is profiled, containerized, and transported for disposal to a permitted hazardous waste facility IAW local, state, and federal regulations.
